Animal Rescue Foundation of Southeastern Pennsylvania Hosts Annual Fundraiser

(MEDIA) November 7, 2007 – The Animal Rescue Foundation of Southeastern PA (ARF SEPA) is throwing it's annual Holiday Paw-ty on Friday, December 14th from 7:30 pm – 10:30 pm at the Upper Providence Fire Company Hall, in Media, PA.

There will be lots of hot and cold buffet style food, festive drinks, great music, a robust silent auction featuring items such as pet portraits, paintings by local artists, gift certificates from local businesses, and much more!

ARF SEPA is an all-volunteer organization that rescues pets out of public shelters. The organization utilizes a network of foster homes to house dogs and cats, instead of operating a traditional shelter.

ARF was recently recognized by the Delaware County SPCA as "Rescue of the Year" because of the unprecedented number of animals they pulled from the shelter – 378 in just a year and a half. But in total, the organization has rescued over 850 animals from a variety of areas.

This annual fundraiser will help the organization to continue rescuing pets in need from shelters and elsewhere.

Jennifer Coccodrilli, ARF's Director said, "We are really looking forward to this party." She continued, "Not only is it our biggest fundraiser of the year, but we love meeting fellow pet lovers in the community. We're very grateful to the Upper Providence Fire Company for allowing us to host the event at their facility."

Not only is the event open to the public, but ARF hopes many local animal lovers will attend, not just to support the organization, but to meet fellow animal lovers in the area.
