

Animal Rescue Foundation of Southeastern PA Opens Adoption Center in Media Four Paws Shoppe Partners with Local Rescue Organization

(MEDIA) January 30, 2008 – The Animal Rescue Foundation of Southeastern PA (ARF SEAP) is partnering with Four Paws Shoppe in Media to provide an adoption center for ARF dogs and cats looking for a forever home. The grand opening is at Four Paws Shoppe on Saturday, February 16th from 12:00 noon – 3:00 pm. The adoption center is open every Saturday thereafter throughout the year from 12:00 noon – 3:00 pm.

Additionally, cats are available for adoption at the store during the week by appointment. They will live at Four Paws Shoppe and be cared for by store owner, Melissa Prorock, until homes are found.

ARF SEPA is an all-volunteer organization that utilizes a network of foster homes to house dogs and cats, instead of operating a traditional shelter. Four Paws Shoppe is a unique pet store that carries all natural pet food and treats, and a full range of supplies for animal companions.

“Our volunteers rescue pets directly from public shelters that must euthanize when full,” says ARF SEPA director Jennifer Coccodrilli. “An opportunity to have an ARF Adoption Center at Four Paws Shoppe is wonderful because it makes it easier for people to meet our dogs and cats and get them quickly adopted into forever homes. In turn, we can rescue that many more animals out of shelters.”

She added, “We’re extremely grateful to Melissa Prorock of Four Paws for opening her heart and her shop to ARF SEPA.”
